Join us in this event that aims to create a space to promote a network with research groups, stakeholders and practitioners mainly from Brazil and UK who have experience in marine litter and clean-up (and/or citizen science) initiatives. We will be examining existing initiatives, discuss the perceived benefits and applications of these initiatives along with reservations that need to be overcome, and examine how clean-up and citizen science can act as a useful tool in understanding marine litter and encouraging behaviour change in society. We will also have a field trip to have hands-on experience with citizen science protocols. Based on the conclusions from this interactive workshop, we hope to then produce written guidance with the necessary steps needed to maximise the usefulness of marine litter citizen science projects for all involved (scientists, volunteers and practitioners).

Dr Kayleigh Wyles

is an Environmental Psychology lecturer at the University of Surrey, UK. Her work has been looking at the impact marine litter has on individuals (e.g. the impact it has on people's health and wellbeing) and the impact we have on this global problem (e.g. the role human behaviour plays and the main factors that drive each behaviour). Her recent work has examined the impact of participating in clean-up initiatives on the volunteers.





Dr Alexander Turra

Professor at the Oceanographic Institue of São Paulo University and holder of the UNESCO Chair on Ocean Sustainability. My scientific work cover a range of different areas of marine science including governance, management and conservation, marine spatial planning, environmental impact assessment, climate change, marine litter and ecology. My research interests also include investigations into the links between science and public policy and the monitoring of environmental quality.

Dr Natalia Pirani Ghilardi-Lopes

is a biologist with a PhD in marine ecology from the University of São Paulo (USP). Nowadays, she is an Associate Professor at Federal University of ABC (UFABC - São Paulo State, Brazil). Her main research interests are related to the development and evaluation of: 1) marine and coastal environmental education activities and 2) citizen science protocols. Also, she develops studies on the ecology of rocky shore benthic communities.





Larissa de Araújo Kawabe (MSc)

is a biologist and PhD student in Evolution and Diversity at Federal University of ABC (UFABC, Brazil). Her main research interests are focused on the development and evaluation of citizen science protocols for monitoring coastal and marine environments, environmental education and its social impact, and on the use and evaluation of information and communication technologies as a support tool for educational and scientific purposes.




